Village community centre updates

During August we completed monthly inspections by the fire service contractor.

Thermal scanning has been performed on electricity pillars and various community facilities.

Additionally, maintenance activities involved replacing the broken toilet seat and shower head in the men's showers. Repainting and repair work, including the men's, ladies', and disabled bathrooms along with fixing broken tiles, have been successfully completed. Future enhancements entail repainting the walls and ceilings of the community centre.

Throughout the past month, Frank and I have dedicated approximately three weeks to pruning pear trees along the road, clearing gutters, and ensuring safety by trimming trees from stage 1 to 4. As spring approaches, we are gradually resuming mowing, weeding, and pruning tasks.

In the upcoming month, our focus will shift to nourishing the lawn for growth, followed by applying Javelin to combat weed growth.

We plan to fertilize the young trees in the village using a 6-month fertilizer (Troforte - M) and have already begun trimming the lilly pilly along the fence line near the footpath.




Lux Beauty Bus



You will find the team in the garden Monday and Friday mornings.




- having legal capacity to make decisions
- appointing and authorising people to make decisions on your behalf
- different types of appointments including wills, powers of attorney, medical treatment and advanced care directives.

Melissa and Kerrie highlighted the importance to our residents of taking positive steps to actively consider future planning and seeking advice on these matters to avoid pitfalls, rather than just leave it to a "what will be will be" process.

The clarity and relevance of the presentation was much appreciated by the 35 residents who attended, as was the willingness of Melissa and Kerrie to respond to questions and comments from the floor. Additionally, the bundle of support resources and materials from Barwon Community Legal Service was most welcome.
